# IPP Interoperability Event

---



- During the August 2011 F2F we decided the IPP/2.0 interoperability event will be virtual using the CUPS ipptool program and conformance test files
- February 2012 release of ipptool covers:
  - All required operations and attributes for IPP/2.0
  - Partial coverage of operations and attributes for IPP/2.1
  - Basic testing for existence of IPP/2.2 operations and attributes
- Future update to include tests for undefined attribute and group tags, plus additions to IPP/2.1 and IPP/2.2 tests
- Test results to be sent to Mike Sweet ([msweet@apple.com](mailto:msweet@apple.com)) for presentation at future F2F's
  - Preliminary results for April 2012 F2F
  - "Final" results for June 2012 F2F

# IPP Interoperability Event

---



- Thus far I have not received testing results from any vendor
- I have feedback from three members:
  - One member had issues with the ipptool binaries not working on Windows XP (fixed in February 2012 release)
  - One member had issues with the ipptool binaries not working on a Windows Vista system (appears to be a system issue)
  - All three are able to run the tool but have not yet supplied the results of testing
- We need testing results to make this event a success
- We want results from printers regardless of their level of conformance
  - Important to understand where the issues are!
  - Results will be collated and reported anonymously!

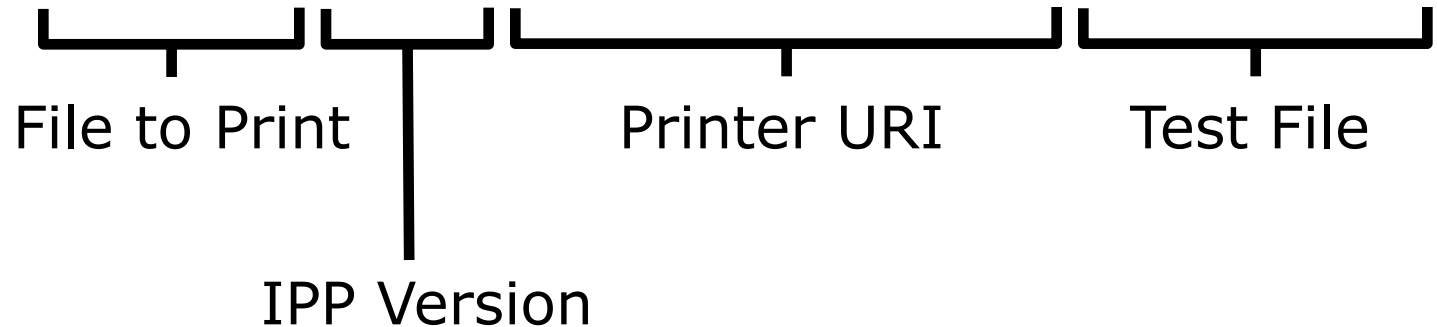

# How to Use ipptool

---

```
ipptool -Itf file.ext -V 2.x ipp://address/path ipp-2.x.test
```



Example for IPP/2.0 printer with PDF support:

```
ipptool -Itf testfile.pdf -V 2.0 ipp://192.168.0.1/ipp \  
ipp-2.0.test | tee make-model-2.0-results.log
```

- Attach the output from ipptool to the email
- Include any comments you like

# IPP Job and Printer Extensions - Set 3 (JPS3)

---



- Current (interim) draft at:
  - <ftp://ftp.pwg.org/pub/pwg/ipp/wd/wd-jobprinterext3v10-20120131-rev.pdf>
- Major Changes/Issues:
  - Changed from “xxx-preferred” to “preferred-attributes (collection)”
  - OpenICC feedback - added “profile-name” Job/Document Template and member attribute, explained how new profiles and media types are “registered” using Set-Printer-Attributes
  - Identified READ-ONLY attributes
  - Added named features to terminology and use the names
  - Added Validate-Document operation
  - Added job-error-action Job Template attribute
  - Added printer-input-tray/output-tray Printer attributes

# IPP Job and Printer Extensions - Set 3 (JPS3 - con't)

---



- Major Changes/Issues (con't):
  - Added discussion of using HTTP If-Modified-Since header with ICC profiles, icons, localization files
  - Profiles, icons, and localization files now SHOULD be Printer-resident
- Proposed Schedule:
  - Prototype draft and WG Last Call during March 2012
  - Stable draft and PWG Last Call to span April 2012 F2F
  - PWG Formal Vote starting in May 2012

# IPP over HTTPS Transport Binding and “ipps” URI Scheme



- Current draft:

- Major Changes/Issues:
  - Mostly editorial changes from IETF and IPP WG reviews
  - Added references to HTTP POST and RFC 2910
  - Added explanation of why numeric addresses should not be used for IPPS
- Proposed Schedule:
  - April 2012 for IESG Last Call
  - June 2012 to RFC Editor’s queue (awaiting publication)



# PWG Media Names 2.0

  - Imported "choice\_" syntax from PWG 5100.7
  - Added various media coating, color, grain, size, source, tooth, and type names discussed in last review

  - Stable draft and PWG Last Call to span April 2012 F2F
  - PWG Formal Vote starting in May 2012

# USB IF - IPP over USB WG

---

- The IPP over USB project has been approved by the USB Forum Board
  - Also covers HTTP over USB
- Working group formation is in process
  - You must sign an IP agreement to join the WG
- Several vendors have signed
  - Still want more printer vendors to sign the IP agreement and join the WG

  - Virtual interoperability event through June 2012 F2F
- IPP Everywhere 1.0
  - Finish prototype draft specifications in Q1/Q2 2012
  - Last Call and Formal Vote Q1/Q2 2012
  - Interoperability event for IPP Everywhere 1.0 in Q3/Q4 2012
- IPP Everywhere 2.0
  - Interim working drafts of IPP Scan Service and IPP FaxOut Service in Q3/Q4 2012
