General Discussion

- Minutes from the March 22nd teleconference (see ftp://ftp.pwg.org/pub/pwg/wims/minutes/cim_070322.pdf) were approved.
- Rick slides were reviewed (see ftp://ftp.pwg.org/pub/pwg/wims/cim/CIM_Reduce_scope_of_update_v01_20070322.pdf). The alternative approaches to reducing scope were discussed:
 1. Remove questionable items
 2. Reconsider priority of some of the groups.
 3. Push hard for most important functions
- Consensus: the first two approaches will be done first (using read-only objects for the purposes of management).
- Rick / Ira suggested approaching CIM Core request support for continuing with the current approach.
- The modern approach to the CIM model to includes settings and capabilities classes to each manageable component.

- Proposal: recast priorities of PWG groups for implementation order. With delimiters for different phases (or implementation groups).
 - Ira to make formal request to e-mail reflector to prioritized list of classes
 - For example, console group could be move to a later group.
- Rick read new paragraph in the PrintOutputTray CR (see ftp://ftp.pwg.org/pub/pwg/wims/cim/CIMCoreCR_PrintOutputTray_093.htm).
 - Ira suggested adding “local console” to the latest addition.
 - Rick to add short paragraph on how localization will be done.
- Rick will request that DMTF Architecture Group add elements to support current localization capabilities.
- Request to Winston (President of DMTF) from Harry to solicit great participation has been deferred. It may be needed later.
- Can we test the process of converting CIM MOF to WS-Management XML schema? Rick to talk with other members of the WS-Management working group to understand process.
- The SM 1.0 does not conflict with the current WIMS-CIM effort.

Counter Specification:

- Bill to use the “raw traffic” definition posted by Ira.
- Walt has expressed interest in implementing the Counter MIBv2.

Next Steps / Open Actions:

- Rick to re-file PrintOutputTray CR today
- Ira to post request for prioritized list of groups to be implemented to e-mail reflector.
- Next telecom scheduled for April 12, 2007 to discuss counter MIB and responses to Ira’s e-mail.
